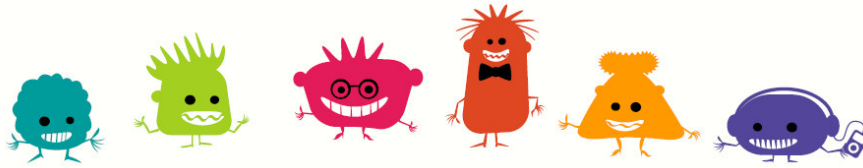

Sing Up is:

Sing Up (SU) is the Music Manifesto National Singing Programme that began April 2007 and runs until March 2011, with £10 million invested each year. Produced by Youth Music with AMV-BBDO, Faber Music and The Sage Gateshead, supported by Government, it aims to raise the status of singing and increase opportunities for primary school-aged children throughout England to enjoy singing as part of their everyday lives. Alongside Sing Up, the Music Manifesto has invested in Choir School Associates, Music Start (for Early Years) and Local Education Authorities (Lifelong Learning).

Your Area Leader:

- There are 35 Area Leaders in counties across the UK. Some are based at LEA Music Services and others at Youth Music Action Zones, or other community organisations. The Devon Area Lead organisation is Plymouth Music Zone, and the contact is Bernie Artuso. It is the Area leader's role to find out what practitioners of the workforce need, and to respond by offering appropriate vocal training. They also link people to singing and training opportunities and where possible, offer support and guidance.

➔ Trouble shooting the website in 2mins!

If you're finding the website slow, try updating your internet browser (to Internet Explorer 8, or even better, Mozilla Firefox), as the newer version are safer, faster and more intelligent when dealing with websites with lots of features, like the Sing Up website.

Try adding Sing Up as a 'trusted site' on your browser. You can do this by going to 'Tools' (in the top left-hand of your browser that says File/Edit/View etc), then selecting Internet Options. In the box that appears, go to 'Privacy' and click once on the big green tick to highlight it. Then click the 'Sites' box a little lower down, and type in <http://www.singup.org> and 'add site'. If it makes a noise and gives you a message saying this can't be done, click ok and have a look down the box a bit. There'll be a tick box saying 'Require server verification (https:) for all sites in this zone'. Untick this. You'll then be able to add <http://www.singup.org> to your trusted sites.

If you then click OK until you come back to your browser window, hold down shift and Ctrl at the same time, and click 'Refresh' (or hit F5 on your keyboard). This is called a 'hard refresh', and will stop your computer remembering the website as it was: very slow.

This should at least triple the speed of the website, fix your searching issues and enable you to download quickly. If it doesn't, or if you'd like me to walk you through any of the above, do give me a ring on the number below - I'm in the office 9am-5:30pm every weekday, and would be happy to answer any questions you have.

If you're going into a school, and none of this seems to work, ask the IT co-ordinator to check his blanket settings for security. It might well be that he's automatically blocking sites hosting video, like YouTube.

➔ Half way through for Devon:

Plymouth Music Zone (PMZ) was selected in July 2008 as the host organisation for Devon Area Leader. PMZ celebrated their 10th Anniversary in June 2009 as a centre of excellence. They are primarily a charity Youth Music Action Zone offering music workshops to a range of settings across Plymouth, and are passionate about the power of music to transform lives. With their Sing Up hat on, they consult with an Advisory Panel to steer Sing Up within Devon. Already an impact has reached several Devon, Torbay and Plymouth primary school teachers and non mainstream settings, and we are looking forward to spreading the word further, with your help! Currently we are focusing on improving transition links to secondary education, evaluation methods, developing young singing leaders and providing sustainable courses for singing leaders.

➔ Sing Up Awards:

A Sing Up Award is a great way to celebrate your schools commitment to placing singing as a high priority in your school; or as a way of identifying ways to introduce this to your school. There are now 54 schools across the county pledged towards achieving a Sing Up Award with 4 already achieving Silver or Gold status. Criteria and hints and tips are available on the Awards Tool page of the Sing Up website and support is available from your Area leader or Music Service Endorser (Elfyn Jones, Annabelle Knowles or Gwyn Price).

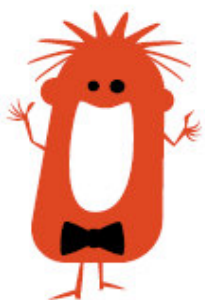
➔ Vocal Platforms:

Is a unique CPD Programme designed by Devon's Area Lead organisation Plymouth Music Zone in response to strategic planning with the Sing Up Advisory Panel. The aim of the programme is to target schools that may need extra help getting singing activity going and offer them the skills and advice to maintain this. On feedback and consultation from delivery so far, the programme has been adjusted to offer the following sessions: Planning, demonstration class, whole staff Inset, 1-2-1 Action Plan with Music Coordinator and follow up feedback session.

➔ Music Services:



Representatives from Devon (DMS), Torbay Academy of Performing Arts (TAPA) and Plymouth Youth Music Services (PYMS) are working closely with the Sing Up Area Leader at Plymouth Music Zone to design future training and vocal strategy for 2010 onwards. Opportunities are increasing for partnership work and improving links across the sectors.



➔ Vocal Force:

WREN Music have been working with aspiring and confident vocal leaders across the county to improve sustainability beyond the Sing Up programme. Participants of the 'singing squads' have already addressed 3 themes: Special Education Needs, Safe Singing and useful warm ups and Going for Quality. The last sessions will include Recording song in the classroom and sharing files as well as Singing in Foreign Languages. Sing Up Training Programme

What was formally known as 'Raising Voices' is now entitled the 'Sing Up Training Programme'. Information can be found on the website under 'Training' and dates are co-ordinated by Sing Up nationally. Bernie Artuso will be helping to facilitate any Devon events and South West events have been included in the Upcoming Events schedule (p.7-9). Participants will now have to pay for this high quality training, delivered by nationally acclaimed vocal leaders, so as to create a culture of valuing singing.

Costs for courses marked * (in Upcoming Events schedule)

£170 - 1 place on 1 course.

£142 - for 2nd or 3rd place booked and so on (meaning a 30% discount on booking for more than 1 place). This discount can be applied to a school booking places for 3 different teachers on either the same or different courses.
