



- Plymouth Music Zone is a successful music education provider and has achieved Youth Music Action Zone status through quality of delivery and management.
- Plymouth Music Zone provides 80-100 weekly music making activities engaging up to 1,200 children and young people and over 20 one off annual events, holiday schools and projects.
- Plymouth Music Zone has engaged over 7,000 children and young people in regular music making activity.
- Plymouth Music Zone has introduced live music through concerts in schools to more than 15,000 students.
- Youth Music has awarded Plymouth Music Zone grants totaling £750,000 of direct investment in the young people of Plymouth
- Plymouth Music Zone is the lead organisation in the city's Space for Sport and Arts revenue scheme worth £128k of investment. This project is increasing sport and cultural activity and community use of our centre and schools in 3 other communities in areas of socio-economic need.
- Youth Music establish Action Zones in areas of social and economic need. This funding is intended as a pump primer for cities/counties to acknowledge and take ownership of the residual project/organisation.
- Plymouth Music Zone has already attracted over £1,500,000 of capital and revenue funding since 1999.
- Plymouth Music Zone has acknowledged other city organisations such as The Soundhouse, Plymouth Musicians Cooperative, Deep Blue Sound and Instrumental Music Services by using its funding to buy in their skills and resources (Over £100k of investment).
- Plymouth Music Zone provides employment for 9 full time members of staff and around 30 freelance tutors and support staff.
- Plymouth Music Zone is expected to deliver a new Youth Music Initiative, 'Music Leader Network'. This will bring further investment of over £130,000 (over an 18 month period) to establish a quality, well-trained network of community and education based musicians. This is a regional initiative showcasing Plymouth and its resources to the whole of the South West.
- Plymouth Music Zone is a registered charity and not for profit company. Under spent or generated revenue will be re invested in the young people of Plymouth.
- Plymouth Music Zone is a non partisan organisation that has the interest of Plymouth's musical future at its core.
